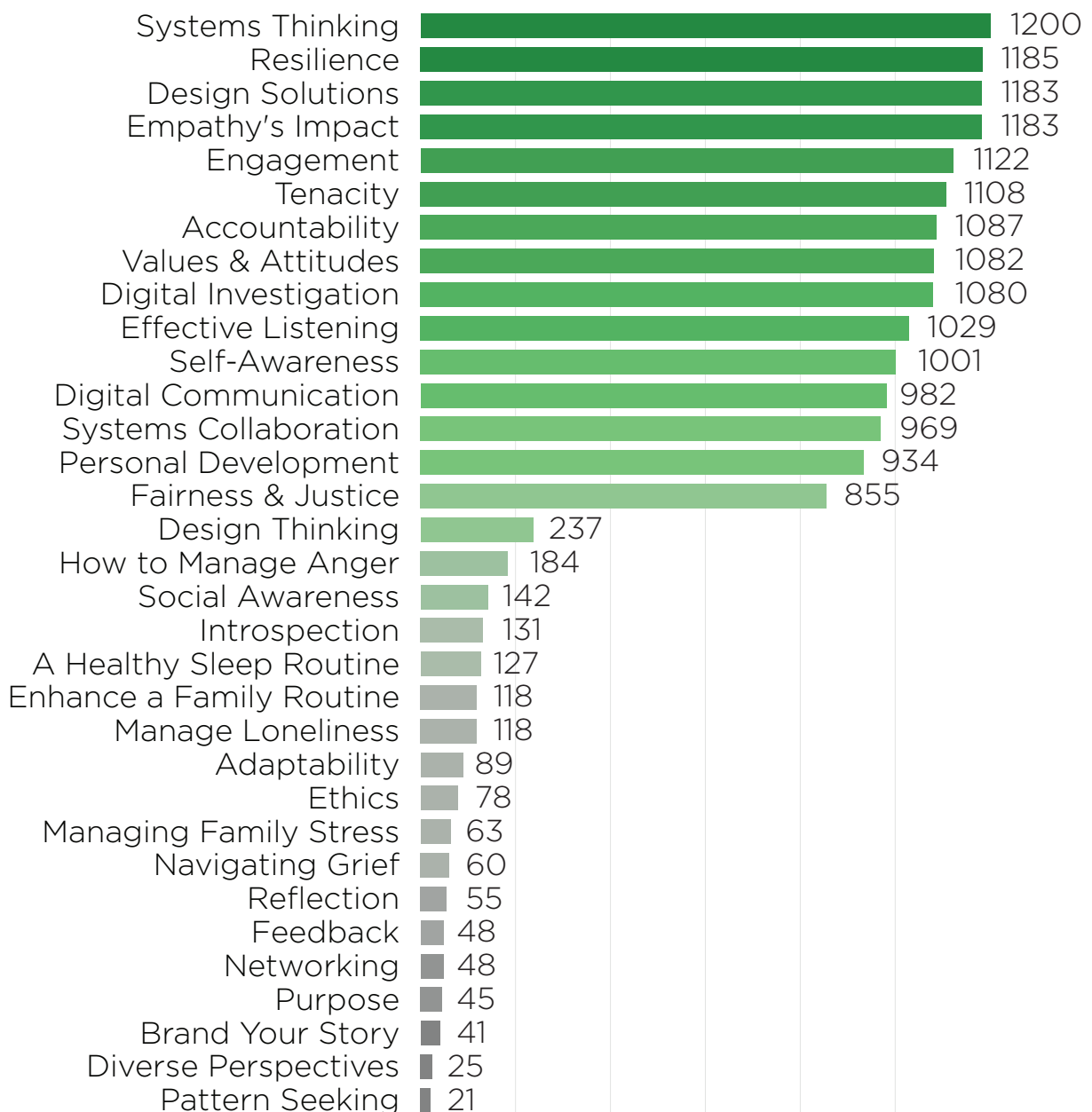

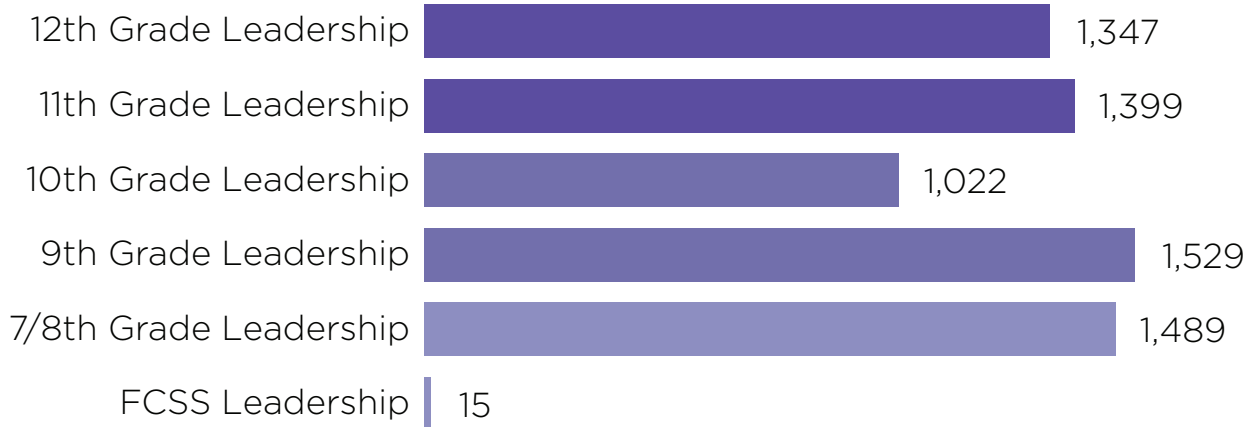

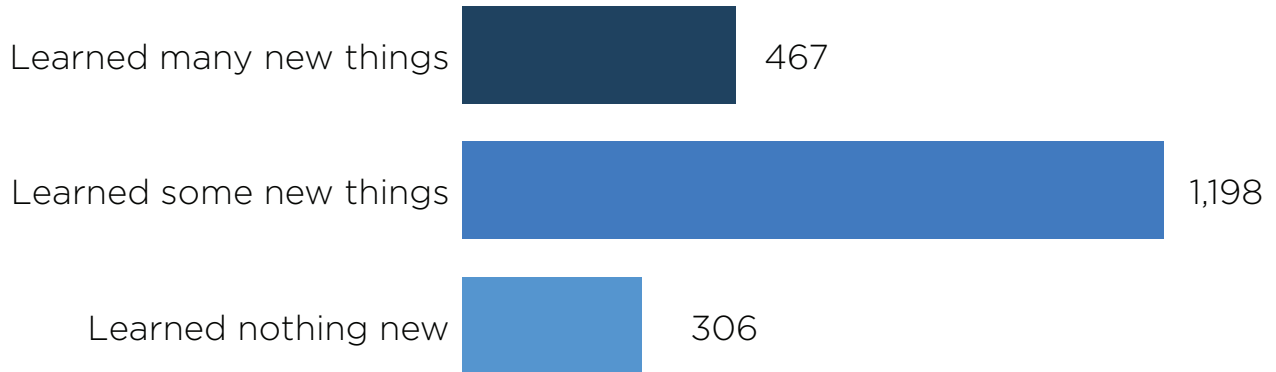

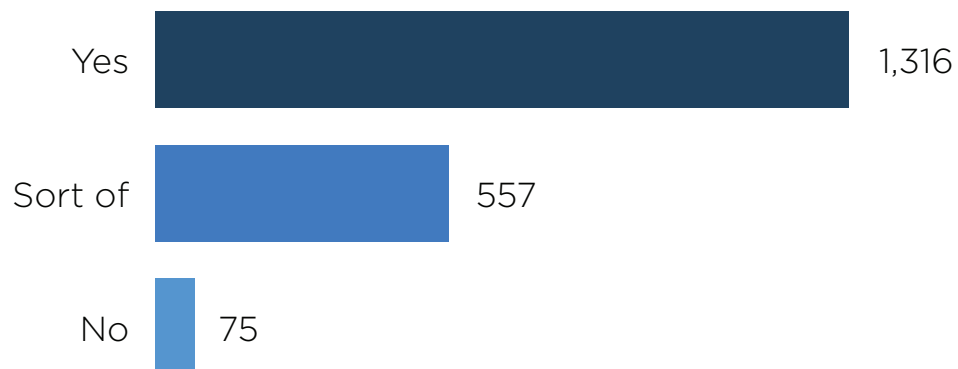

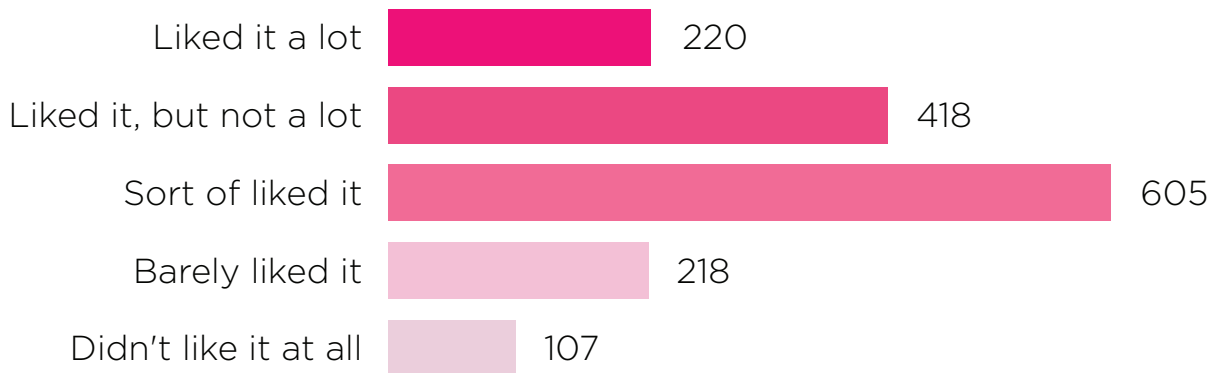

DO YOU THINK THIS LESSON CAN ENCOURAGE OTHER PEOPLE TO BE LIFELONG LEARNERS?

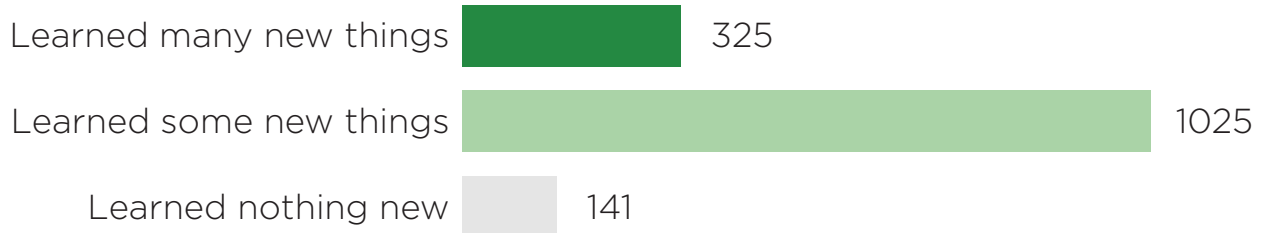


COMPARED TO WHAT YOU KNEW BEFORE, HOW MUCH DID YOU LEARN FROM THIS LESSON?

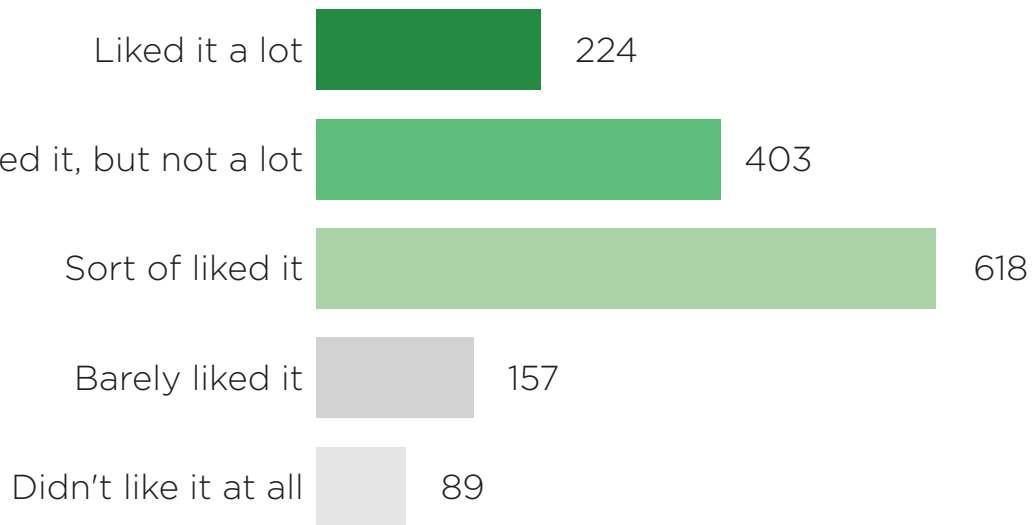

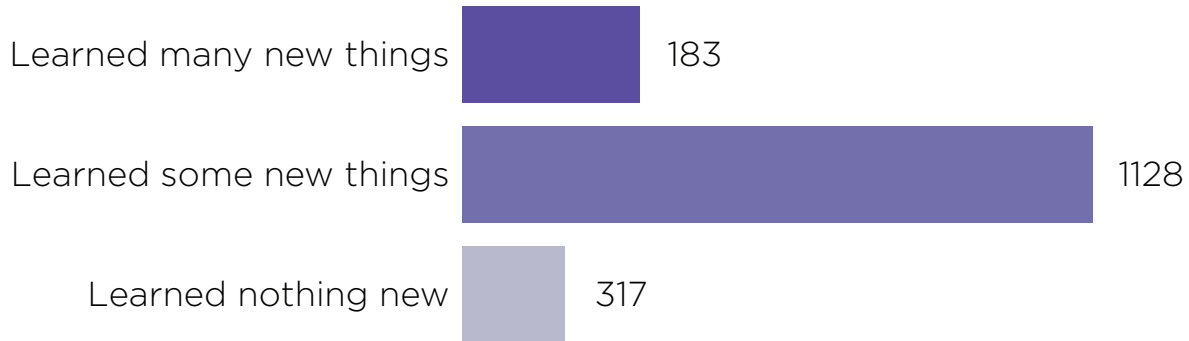

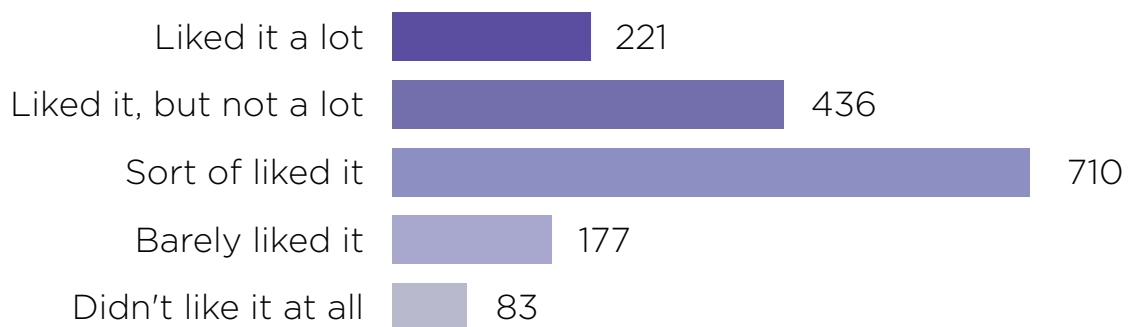

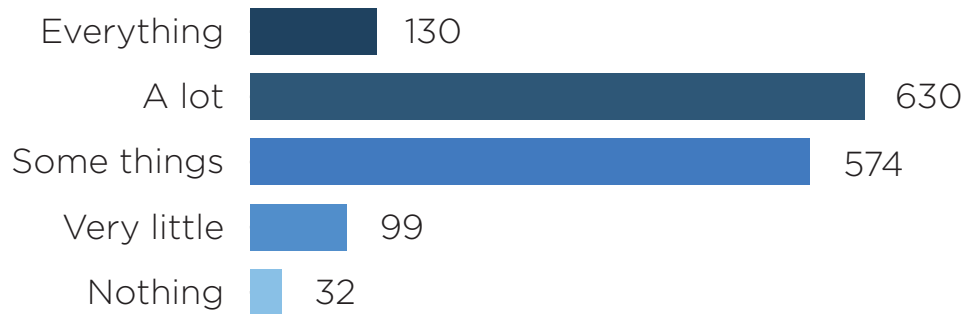

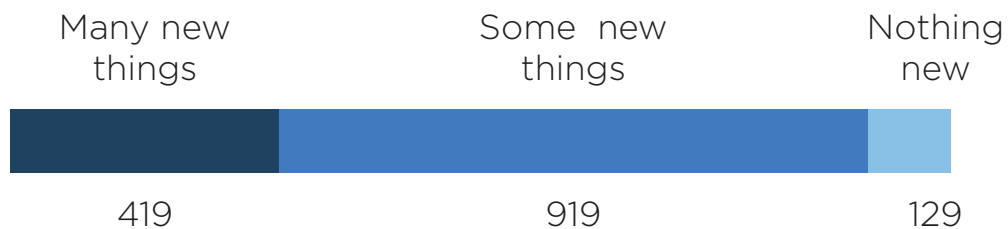
AFTER THIS LESSON, HOW MUCH DO YOU KNOW ABOUT BEING RESILIENT?

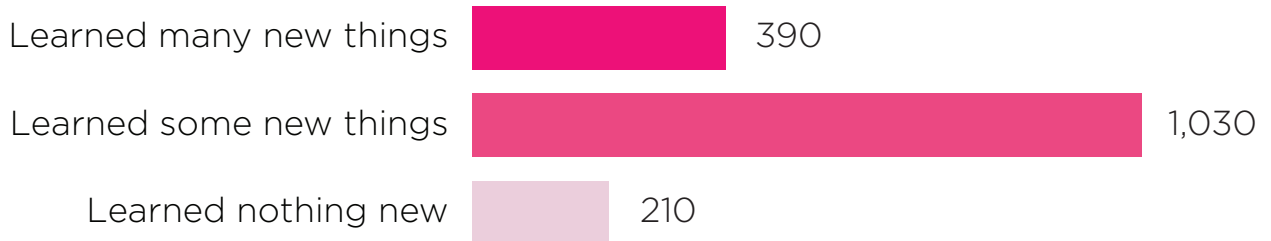


COMPARED TO WHAT YOU KNEW BEFORE, HOW MUCH DID YOU LEARN FROM THIS LESSON?

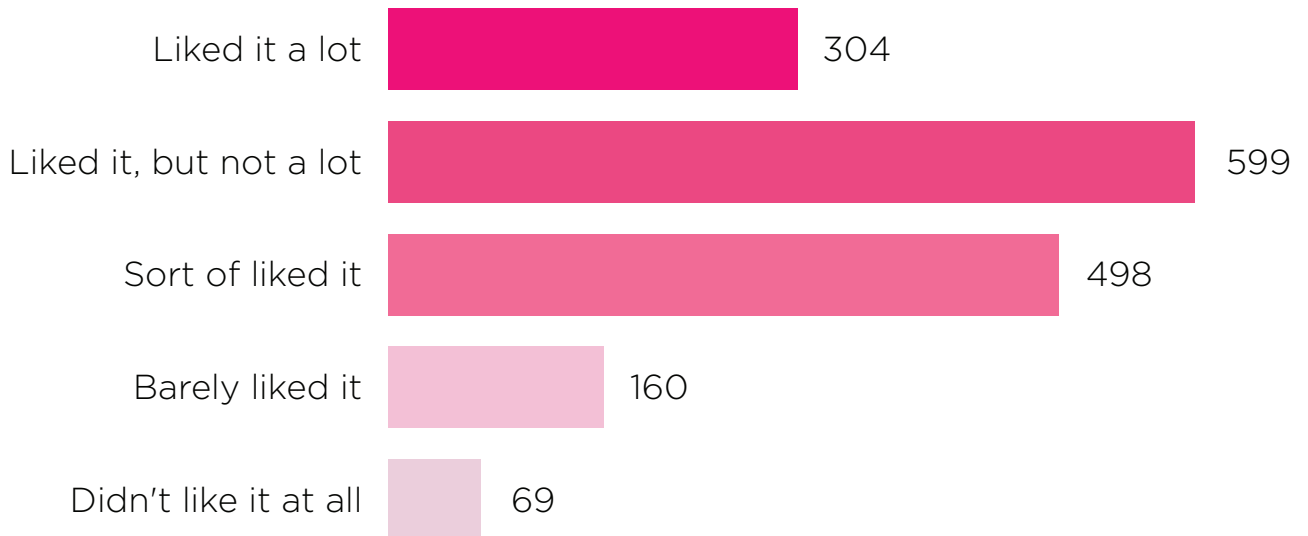

HOW MUCH DID YOU LIKE THIS LESSON?

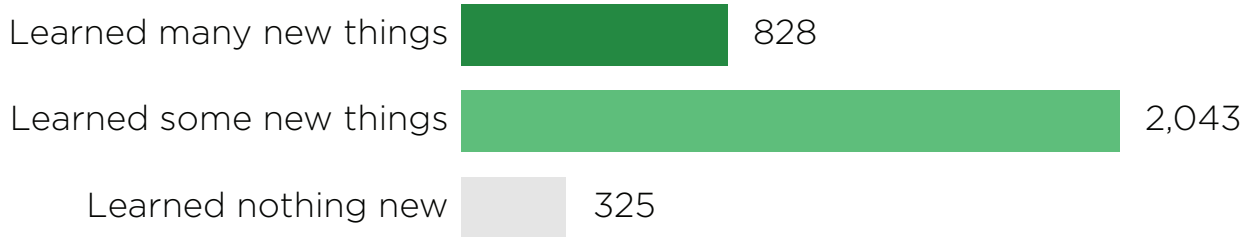


CAN THIS LESSON HELP OTHERS WITH THEIR TEAMWORK SKILLS?

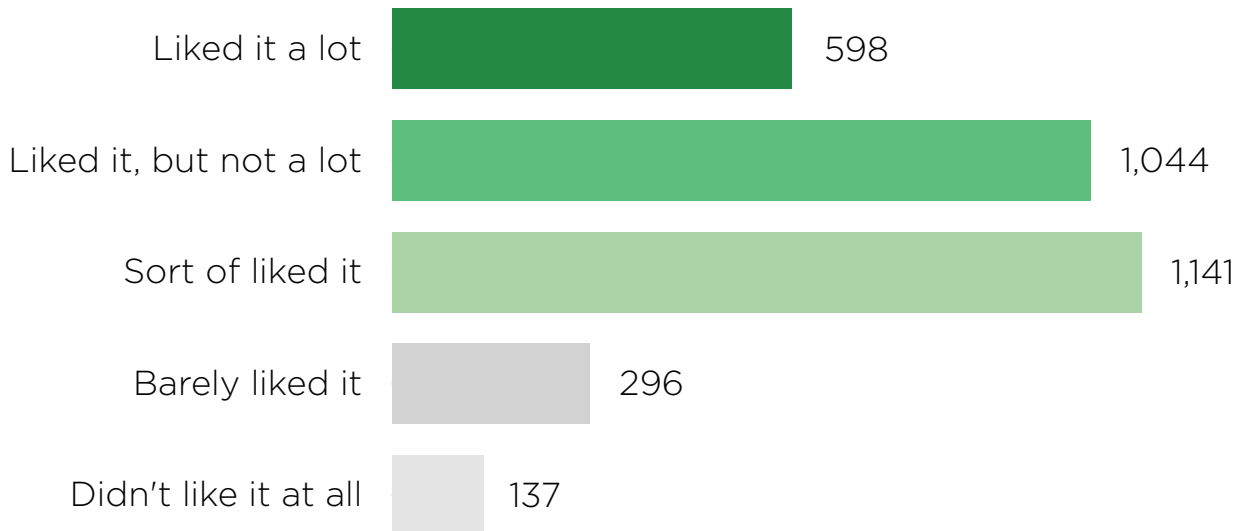

HOW MUCH DID YOU LIKE THIS LESSON?

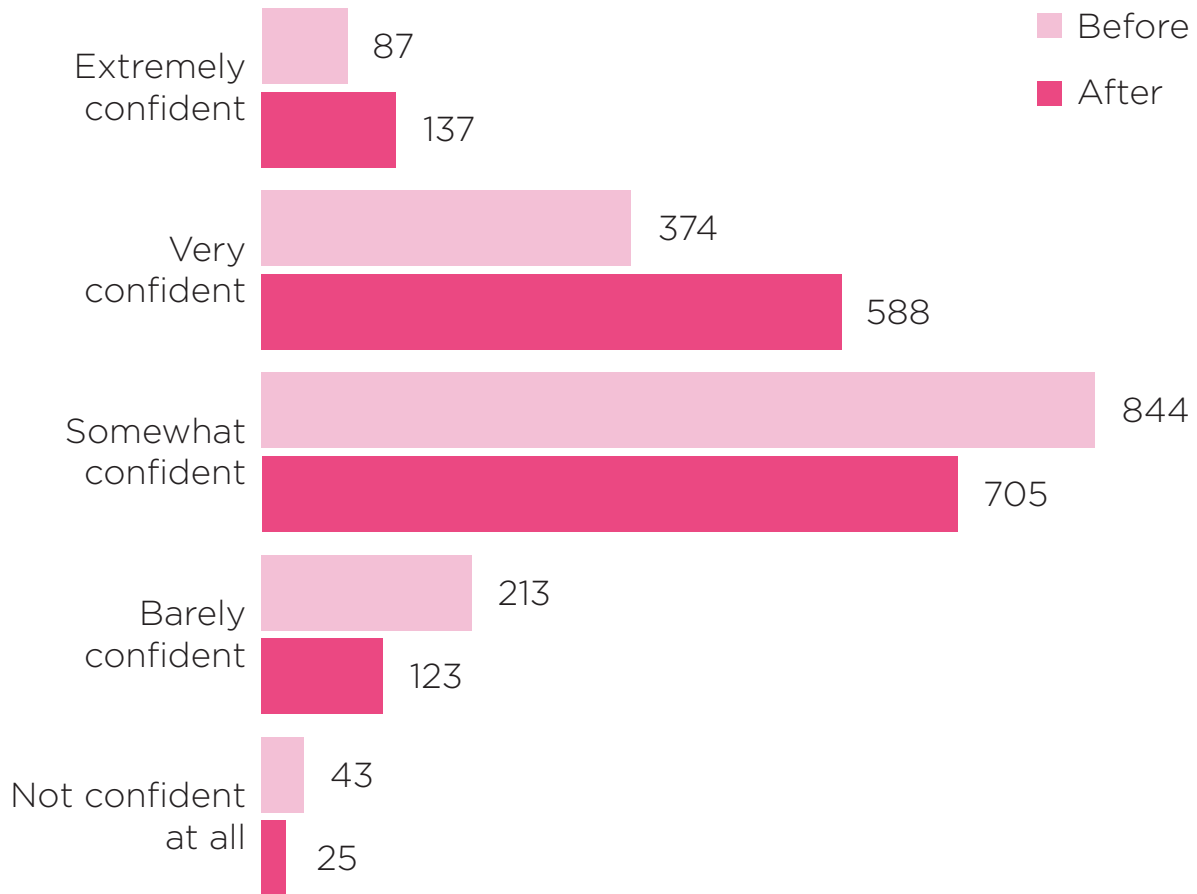

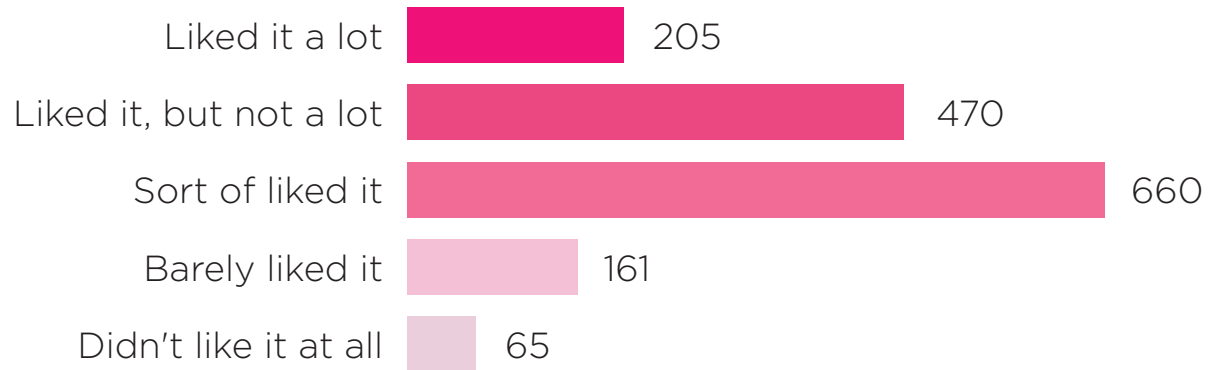
THIS DIFFERENCE IS STATISTICALLY SIGNIFICANT.



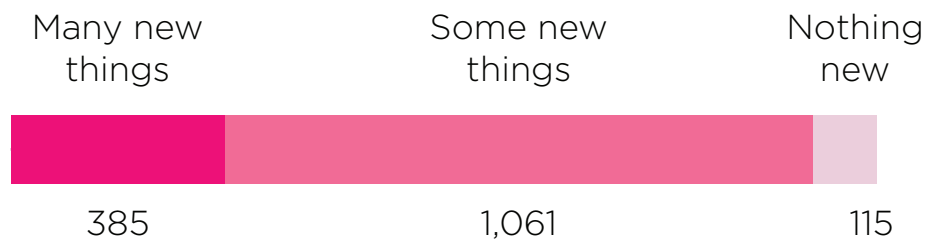
Based on a paired t-test, this difference is considered to be extremely statistically significant ($t = 10.89$ [1,560] p -value = 0.0001). Before Mean Score = 3.16 (SD = 0.83, SEM = 0.02, N = 1,561) vs. after Mean Score = 3.44 (SD = 0.82, SEM = 0.02, N = 1,561).

COMPARED TO WHAT YOU KNEW BEFORE, HOW MUCH DID YOU LEARN FROM THIS LESSON?

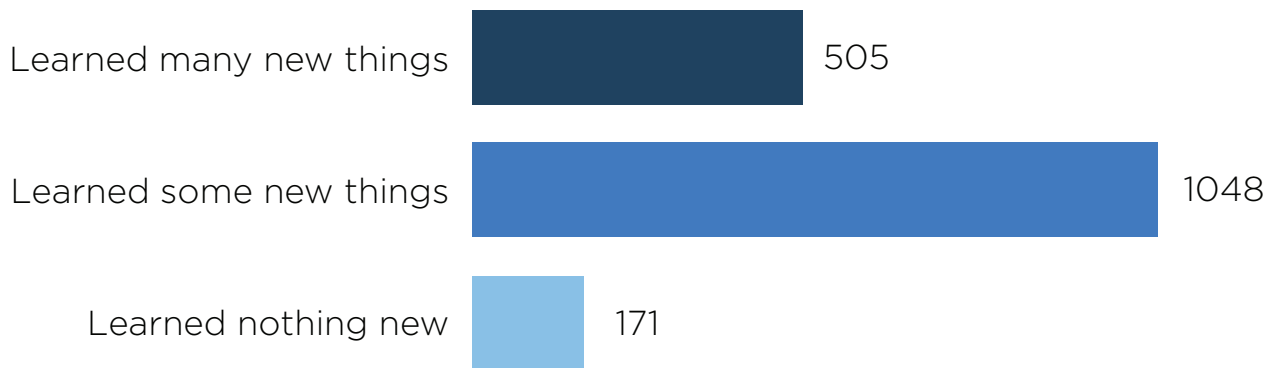

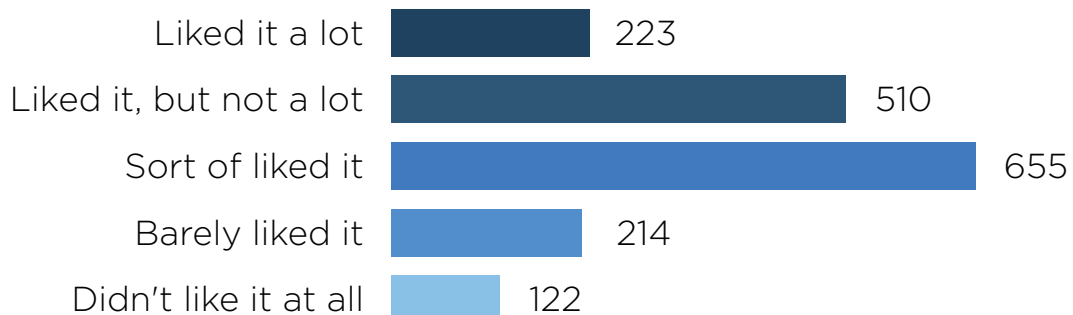

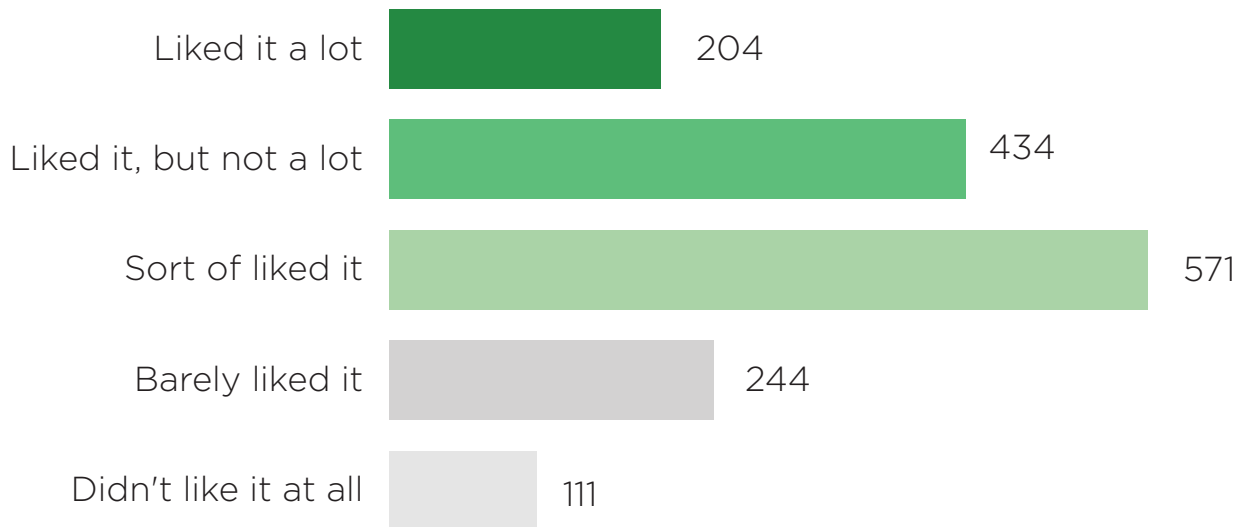

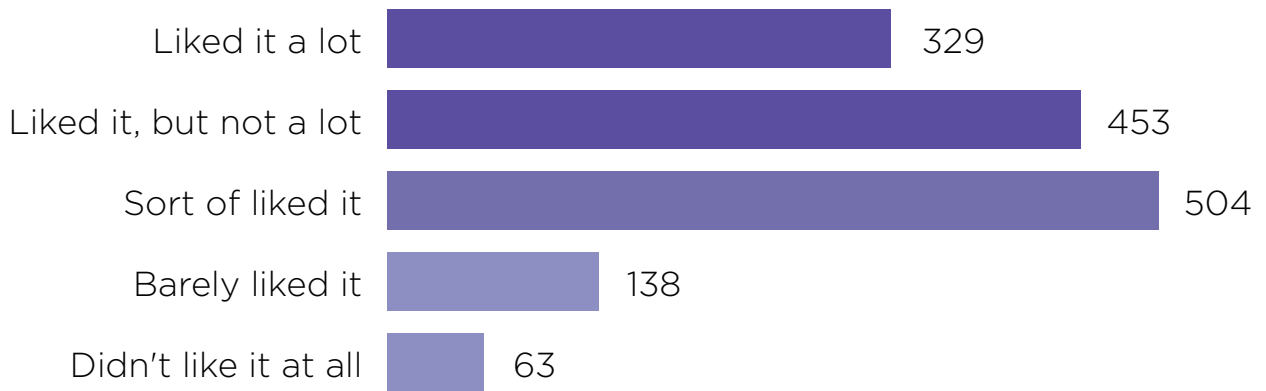
